

SOLAR BIRD FEEDER

Review all information before using this product. Save this manual for future reference.

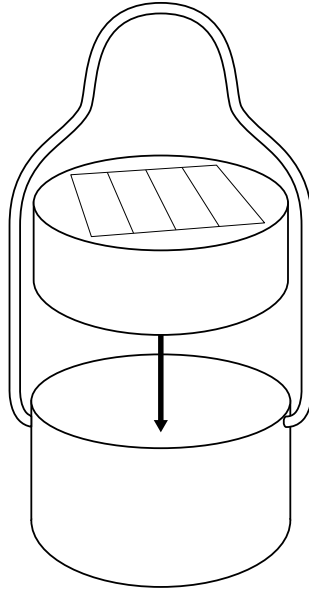
OPERATION

1. Turn the power switch on the solar panel 'ON'.
2. Place solar panel into wire hanger.
3. Attach feeder to bottom hook.
4. Place the solar bird feeder in a location that will receive 6-8 hours of full, direct sunlight.

FIRST TIME USE: The solar panel will require at least 8 hours of full and direct sunlight to charge the battery. Make sure the unit is turned 'ON' while charging.

- Light turns on automatically at night when fully charged.
- Avoid placing in shade and strong nighttime lighting.

IMPORTANT: The feeder is equipped with a drainage hole to prevent moisture and precipitation buildup that can cause seed to rot. If using smaller seed, we recommend placing a small stone over the drainage hole to prevent seed from spilling out but still allow water to drain.



RECHARGEABLE BATTERY

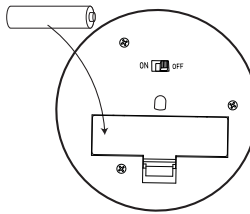
The battery, like all rechargeable batteries, has a limited life span and becomes less efficient with repeated charge/discharge cycles. As the capacity of the battery reduces, so does the operating time, and the battery will need replacing.

IMPORTANT: Only use compatible solar rechargeable batteries; incompatible alternatives may damage the system and will void the warranty.

CLEANING

1. Remove the solar panel and gently wipe it off with a soft cloth.
2. Clean the inside and outside of the feeder with mild detergent, warm water, and a soft cloth.
3. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and allow the feeder to completely dry before adding seed and replacing solar panel.

REPLACING THE BATTERY




1. Turn the solar panel 'OFF'.
2. Remove the battery cover and gently remove the battery.
3. Paying attention to the positive and negative terminals, gently insert a new solar rechargeable battery.
4. Replace the battery cover.

WARNING

INGESTION HAZARD — This item contains a battery. Keep battery out of reach of children and pets.


USE & CARE

- The solar feature is designed for outdoor use only.
- Keep the solar panel clean by wiping it down with a damp cloth. Clean solar panels will absorb more sunlight.
- Check for water accumulation inside the bird feeder on a regular basis, especially after rain and temperature changes that cause condensation.
- Do not use chemicals or abrasive materials to clean the unit.
- Do not allow the feeder or solar panel to freeze; store indoors during cold conditions.
- Store the feeder indoors during high-wind conditions.

 This product uses a rechargeable battery. When the battery can no longer be used, it should be removed from the unit and recycled. The battery must not be incinerated or composted. Recycle the battery in accordance with local laws and regulations.

Any modification to the product or failure to follow recommended care will void the product warranty.
